



St. John the Baptist Youth Activities Committee Disciplinary Action Plan

The following disciplinary action plan will be instituted for any student-athlete participation in a YAC activity whose behavior has been determined to be unacceptable.

The behavior of our student-athletes should be in compliance with that of Catholic School Standards.

Any student-athlete who is disruptive or disrespectful in any manner during a game or practice may see his/her playing time reduced. The head coach, instructor, leader, or moderator involved in the activity, along with the YAC Chair or Athletic Director, will make the determination as to what type of behavior results in disciplinary action.

Communication on all levels is important; therefore, the athlete, parents, and the YAC Chair and/or Athletic Director must be notified upon the first infraction.

1. 1st infraction will result in a verbal warning and an appointment or meeting with the student-athlete and the parent along with the coach/instructor and the YAC Chair or Athletic Director.
2. 2nd infraction will result in a seven (7) day suspension from all YAC functions and activities.
3. 3rd infraction will result in the removal of the student-athlete from that specific activity for the remainder of the season.

We have read and understand the above, and hereby agree the same shall apply to the following St. John the Baptist sports during the school year: Volleyball, Football, Cheerleading, Cross-country, Track, Basketball, Soccer and Softball.
