Dear 2009-10 5th – 8th grade parents,

If your child is interested in participating in CYO sports next year they will need to get a physical ASAP. The physical form can be found on the school website-stjohnsfw.org or in the school office. Please hold onto the form and give it directly to the coach. **Do not send into school.** We will need to have the physical **before** your child can practice. Fall sports start in July and August, so after you read this letter, call your doctor and make an appointment- **don't wait!** If you had a physical this spring it will be good for the fall.

ELIGIBILITY

The extracurricular eligibility policy is in the school handbook. Eligibility for all fall sports will be determined by the last report card received in the prior school year.

FOOTBALL

Coach Carroll will visit the classrooms and pass out a flyer concerning football start dates. Gregg Norris (744-2033) is the football equipment director. An equipment deposit fee of **\$100.00 is due at equipment handout.** A nonrefundable participation fee of \$75.00 is due prior to the start of practices.

Luers football camp is July 20-23. Registration forms are available on the Luers' website at www.bishopluers.org. Equipment handout (helmet and shoulder pads) for those **ONLY** going to Luers camp will be Wed. July 15 from 6-7 pm in Father Ryder Hall (please enter through the Northwest door near the rectory). The coaches will notify players of the pre-season equipment handout date closer to the start of the actual St. John football season.

This year, **you will need to purchase your own girdle** (for holding the hip, tail and thigh pads). In addition, you will also need to provide a practice shirt (that fits over the shoulder pads) and white practice football pants (that hold knee pads). Game jerseys/pants are **NOT TO BE WORN FOR PRACTICE.** Please do not wait until the last minute to purchase these items as they go quickly the closer we get to football season.

VOLLEYBALL

Volleyball practice will start in August. The coach will determine when their team will start practice. The coach will contact you directly. The nonrefundable participation fee is \$35 and the uniform deposit is \$50. We are still in need of 5th, 7th and 8th grade coaches.

CHEERLEADING

The cheerleading head coach is Tonya Gonzales. Assisting her this year will be Kathi Stronczek and Lori Archbold. The nonrefundable participation fee is \$35 and the uniform deposit is \$100.

FEES AND DEPOSITS

The YAC will collect nonrefundable participation fees and equipment/uniform deposits before each sport starts. *The equipment deposit will be collected for the first sport your child participates in and will be held by our treasurer until the end of the school year.* Please make your checks payable to St. John YAC.

REQUIRED FORMS

All athletes participating in CYO sports must have a current physical form filled out and signed by a physician **BEFORE THEY START PRACTICE**. This is a CYO rule. Do not send the form into school. The other two forms needed are the CYO consent form and the YAC disciplinary form. All three forms can be found on the school website: www.stjohnsfw.org.
